As you may be informed, the President of South Africa has implemented a 21 nationwide lockdown in an effort to reduce the impact of the COVID-19 virus.

PANTHERA EXPRESS (JHB) will render intermittent and/or on demand consolidated trips to Maputo for the essential commodity sectors only, effective from the 27th March until 16th April 2020.

CATEGORISATION OF ESSENTIAL GOODS DURING LOCKDOWN (Regulation 11A)

Food

- I. Any food products, including non-alcoholic beverages;
- II. Animal food; and
- III. Chemicals, packaging and ancillary products used in the production of any food products

Cleaning and Hygiene Products

- I. Toilet paper, sanitary pads, sanitary tampons, condoms;
- II. Hand sanitisers, disinfectants, soap, alcohol for industrial use, household cleaning products, and personal protective equipment; and
- III. Chemicals, packaging and ancillary products used in the production of any of the above.

Medical

- I. Medical and hospital supplies, equipment and personal protective equipment; and
- II. Chemicals, packaging and ancillary products used in the production of any of the above.

Arrangements can be made so that collections may be done, BUT the exporter needs to be in possession of the Essential Service Provider Certificate which can be obtained from the Department Of Trade and Industry. Unfortunately you will not be permitted to travel if you are not in possession of the required documents.
